Trinity Sunday takes place today Sunday the 27th of May. Masses for the day are 8am Derrinturn Church. At 11am, Mass will take place as usual at Trinity Well and 11am Mass in Kilshanroe. Trinity Sunday, officially called "*The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity*," is one of the few celebrations of the Christian Year that commemorates a reality and doctrine rather than a person or event. On Trinity Sunday, Christians remember and honour the eternal God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Trinity Sunday is celebrated the Sunday after Pentecost, and it lasts only one day, which is symbolic of the unity of the Trinity.
