They must be 16 years old or more, one male and one female. It is permitted for a baptised non-Catholic to act as a “witness” (instead of one Godparent). St. Brigid's Day Crosses made by the children of St Brigid's National School, Ticknevin, will be available for sale at masses on Saturday 26th and Sunday 27th of January in our church in Derrinturn. All monies raised will go towards school funds. The St. Brigid's Cross was traditionally believed to protect the house from fire and disease. As people hung up the cross they said this prayer: ***“May the blessing of God and the Trinity be on this cross, and on the home where it hangs and on everyone who looks at it.”***
