Trip to Lourdes

Over 600 pilgrims travelled to Lourdes from the Diocese of Kildare and Leighlin. That included 100 plus young people. Bishop Denis Nulty led the pilgrimage and there were 20 Priests and some Sisters as well. There were 70 people from Carbury, Edenderry, Rhode, Broadford and Clonbullogue. The Carbury / Edenderry Group had their own Masses in Bartres, and the City of the Poor. Our Diocese led the Blessed Sacrament Procession and the Candle Light Procession on different days. Our opening Mass was in the Chapel of the seven Dolours and we also had Mass at the Grotto where Our Lady appeared to Bernadette in 1858.

The Blessed Virgin asked her "Would you be so kind as to come here for 14 days". The messages she gave her was, Tell the people to come in procession to wash at the spring and tell the Priests to build a Church. Bernadette didn't know who The Lady was, and when she asked for, for a fourth time. Our Lady said, "I am the Immaculate Conception" The Abbe Peremayle ie, The Parish Priest at the time knew then that it was Our Lady because Bernadette was poorly educated and couldn't have made that up, In fact she kept repeating it to herself in case she would forget. It was a very enjoyable pilgrimage. A good time was had by all, and Carbury gave as good as they got at the sing song in the Solitude Hotel, Two nights before we came home. Candles were lit, prayers were said, petitions were left at the Grotto, and bottles of Holy Water were brought home. Thanks to the organisers and to the 100 young people who pushed wheelchairs and gave out cups of water on the really hot days. Already we are looking forward to next year. D.V. Fr Fitzpatrick
