

Next Week's Gospel: Mt 4:1-11

What difference does this make to who I am and how I am? What changes do I need to make in my life to live my baptism more deeply? The themes for each week, such as belonging, healing, renewal, and mission, come from that document - reflecting conversations held across the country in Spring 2025.
