EUCCHARIST

The word 'Eucharist' is another name for the Mass. It comes from a Greek word meaning 'thanksgiving'. The whole Mass is a special prayer of thanksgiving for all that God has given us. Sometimes we use the word to describe the whole Mass and sometimes it is used to describe the Bread of Life. We also talk about the sacrifice of the Mass. This reminds us of the sacrifice that Jesus made for us when he suffered and died on the cross.
