Gates will stay open in Derrinturn cemetery until 10pm up to Cemetery Sunday. There will be no 11am mass in Derrinturn on the 3<sup>rd</sup> July also no 11am mass in Kilshanroe on the 10<sup>th</sup> July.

**Funeral Ministry:** Newbridge, Naas and Clane Parishes have lay funeral ministers who help the priests at times when they are very busy. These ministers may say prayers in the home when someone dies. Other Parishes are being offered the opportunity of training for new lay funeral ministers. Time table is as follows: Early October – come and see evening for parishioners and priests for the whole diocese. One week later – Parish meeting to discuss. Training Early November & Early December 2 Afternoons of training. January - Minister will accompany priest to assist at prayers at wake. February will be training & March – Commissioning of Ministers. June - Check in and reporting back from new ministers.

Over the next two weeks we hope to talk about this new programme, to see if it would be useful and helpful for Carbury Parish. We will check with people who could potentially be ministers and see about submitting a list of names to the diocese by 12<sup>th</sup> July. Comments and observations are welcome.

**First Ever Diocesan Pilgrimage To Lourdes** will take place from 16<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> July 2017, led by Bishop Denis Nulty. Focus will be on our 50 sick people who will have 24 hour hospital care. Volunteers are needed as (1) Brancardiers, who will wheel and carry people. (2) Handmaids who will look after the sick. (3) Nurses – who are on the live register. (4) Doctors. These will form the Lourdes Hospitality and the 24 hours hospital staff. Some have volunteered already as nurses and doctors. 1040 rooms have been block booked for Pilgrims. Hotel rooms are given on a first come first served basis- including the solitude etc. There will be a choir of 100 under the direction of Fr Liam Lawton. Singers are invited from Parish Choirs and others as well. There will be bands from Portlaoise, Carlow, Parish Officers. One aircraft will be assigned especially for sick people and their helpers. The Bishop has asked that there be no Parish Pilgrimages next year (2017). The cost is €719 – sharing (with €50 reduction for a child), plus €8.50 Hotel tax and cost of bus to Dublin Airport. Booking forms are available in the Parish Office. Excess monies will go to helping pay for those who are sick plus a subsidy for the staff. Parishes can fund raise. We now have 55 weeks to prepare, we ask God’s blessing as we begin. Bishop Denis has asked for an all out effort across the Diocese to make the Pilgrimage a great success. He prays that the light of Our Lady shine on all who travel.
