***Irish Cancer Society Hurling for Cancer:*** For the fifth year in a row horse racing legend Jim Bolger and champion jockey Davy Russell will bring household names in GAA and horse racing together to take part in Hurling for Cancer Research, a celebrity hurling match in aid of the Irish Cancer Society. To date the event has raised €400,000 to help fund innovative cancer research projects in Ireland and the aim is to raise a further €100,000 this year. Kilkenny's Brian Cody will manage Davy Russell's side, while former Wexford manager, Liam Griffin, will be coaching Jim Bolger's team for an almighty clash of the ash. Holder of ten All Ireland medals, Henry Shefflin, will be joined on the pitch by former Ireland striker Niall Quinn, Irish Sportswoman of the Year Katie Walsh, and a plethora of well-known jockeys and GAA stars including the iconic Micheal O'Muircheartaigh who will serve as craoltoir on the day. The event takes place on Tuesday the 9<sup>th</sup> of August 2016 at 6.30pm in St Conleths Park Newbridge. All money raised will go to the Irish Cancer Society to fund researchers improving the lives of people across the country affected by cancer.

With the fifth beatitude from Matthew's Gospel as its theme, World Youth Day 2016 focuses on celebrating God's mercy in alignment with the Holy Year of Mercy proclaimed by Pope Francis. Catholics from around the world are gathering in Kraków, Poland to experience the local

culture and global Church on a pilgrimage of faith. Kraków is the ideal location as the site of revelations of God's mercy and forgiveness including divine appearances to Saint Faustina, the martyrdom of Saint Maximilian Kolbe in Auschwitz, and Saint John Paul II's legacy.

In his homily announcing the Holy Year of Mercy, Pope Francis explained, *"We are called to look beyond, to focus on the heart in order to see how much generosity everyone is capable of. No one can be excluded from the mercy of God."* His hope is that during this year we may find *"the joy of rediscovering and rendering fruitful God's mercy."* Poland is also the home country of Saint John Paul II. When visiting the Divine Mercy Shrine in 1997, he said, *"There is nothing more man needs than Divine Mercy—that love which is benevolent, which is compassionate, which raises man above his weakness to the infinite heights to the holiness of God."* Throughout his life and papacy, Saint John Paul II's mercy and forgiveness extended to all he encountered including his attempted assassin. *"I also pray for my brother who shot me, whom I have sincerely forgiven,"* he shared upon visiting him in prison.
