Apparition Hill is a new film based on the happenings at the sacred mountain side village of Medjugorje, Bosnia where since 1981 a group of young people have claimed to have apparitions and revelations of Mary, the mother of God. This film documents the journey of 6 unknown pilgrims, from very diverse backgrounds, having won a competition in the USA to journey to Medjugorje. It tells their story and answers some of the great questions of this spiritual oasis in a world of war, so devoid of peace. It has received rave reviews throughout the world and now can be seen in Ireland. Plans are progressing well for the Inaugural Diocesan Lourdes Pilgrimage, 16th to 21st July 2017. By the end of October, we hope to have an idea of the numbers that will travel. There is a big

interest across the diocese. The opening Mass of the pilgrimage will be at the Grotto of Our Lady. Kildare Diocese will lead the Rosary procession on one of the evenings. They will also lead the Blessed Sacrament procession on an afternoon. There will be a Reconciliation Service and a healing service. All in all there will be two major ceremonies each day.

There will also be free time to visit Bartres and other places of intent. There are 50 beds booked in the hospital for the sick. Fr Tom Little is Chaplain to the sick. The chief medical officer is Dr. Little. 4 doctors and 20 Nurses have volunteered so far. More are needed.

There is an opening for young people (18 years +) to help on a voluntary basis with pushing wheelchairs and beds and accompanying the sick. Those younger can be accompanied by an adult. The key to Lourdes is those who are ill. They will be our priority.

The person in charge of catering, for the hospital, food-wise has been appointed- more helpers are needed. Tee shirts and insignia with a St Brigids Cross will be provided for volunteers and others. There will be socials at night.

There will be 3 assemblies to help prepare us for the pilgrimage with the themes of Prayer, Pilgrimage and Comraderie. One of the assemblies will possibly be in Edenderry. If you intend to travel, book early if possible. The Edenderry/Carbury/Rhode/Broadford people are trying to stay in the Solitude Hotel, but it needs to be booked in a first come first served basis. The choir are staying in the Alba Hotel. Six hotels are set aside for bookings. Forms are available in the Parish Office. We ask the intercessions of Our Lady, help of the sick, on our first Diocesan pilgrimage, and God's blessings on us all. *Fr John Fitzpatrick PP*
