'Miles for Mission': Archbishop Kieran O'Reilly, Archbishop of Cashel and Emly, will lead the inaugural 'Miles for Mission' walk on Saturday the 22nd October. His Excellency, Mr Richard Opembe, the Kenyan Ambassador to Ireland will also join in the event which will begin at 11am in the Phoenix Park, Dublin.

The centre, which was co-founded by Franciscan Missionary Sister Patricia Speight from Belfast, cares for the most impoverished and destitute people in Nakuru. Sister Patricia says that funds like those provided by World Missions Ireland are vital and help ease the constant financial strain.

Speaking ahead of the event, Sally McEllistrim, PR Manager for WMI, said, "We are delighted that Archbishop Kieran is joining us and the presence of the Kenyan Ambassador is wonderful too, given the huge numbers of Irish missionaries with links to Kenya. We are hoping that our event will be a lovely occasion for people to come together, enjoy the missionary camaraderie and help raise funds for a wonderful cause as well. This event will give us time perhaps to reflect on our own 'missionary walk in life' and the imprint we are making. It will be a fun occasion too as missionaries have a wealth of wonderful stories and so we will raise spirits as we raise funds."
