Message from Trócaire: Earlier in the year we communicated to you that the Trócaire box would not change from 2016 to 2017. However, since then some important information with regard to our charitable expenditure has changed. This is positive news for Trócaire because 92.7% out of every euro now goes on charitable expenditure as opposed to 91%. Although it will be disappointing for some of you to hear that the box is changing for 2017, which we humbly apologise for, in the interest of accountability and transparency, we have to let the Irish public know of this change and therefore the pie chart on the existing 2016 Trócaire box will need to change. Furthermore, following the feedback in 2016 that there were some challenges explaining the work of Trócaire without a programme participant on the box, the side panels of the boxes printed for 2017 will also be updated to include images and a story from our country of focus. We are keeping the overall look and feel of the box the same as 2016, which will keep any redesign costs to an absolute minimum. We trust you will accept the rationale for needing to make these changes to the box for 2017 and again our sincere apologies for changing when we had previously advised differently. As usual we will provide you with a supply of boxes to your parishioners during Lent next year.
