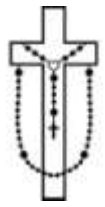

Next Week's Gospel: Luke 19:1-10.

Mission Month of October: Next Sunday is Mission Sunday, the annual worldwide Catholic celebration of mission in its fullest sense. Pope Francis describes mission “*As a passion for Jesus and a passion for his people*”. Our financial and spiritual help enables missionaries to breathe faith, hope and charity into the lives of people who need it most. Sharing the message and sharing financially with those in developing countries is our Christian duty. Our prayers and financial offerings on Mission Sunday go towards supporting missionaries and their mission projects where the Church is new, young or poor. A special collection will be taken up next Sunday in aid of our brothers and sisters currently on mission, allowing them to continue their work.

Parish Led Sacramental Preparation and Celebration: The engagement of parents and the wider faith community in preparation for sacraments is one of the most important and challenging tasks that face our parishes. During the coming year we hope to host conversations about the variety of ways in which this task is accomplished and how we might continue to enable parents to be full participants in their child’s faith journey. All partners will be invited to participate. This conversation will take place after Christmas and will, hopefully, begin a new stage on our journey to more authentic preparation and celebration of the sacraments.

World Youth Day – Did you know?

From the 24th to 31st of July Bishop Denis led 133 pilgrims from Kildare and Leighlin and a total of 1,600 pilgrims travelled from Ireland. They were hosted by the parish of Giebultow just outside Krakow. Seven diocesan Priests travelled with us. Sean Gallagher from Two Mile House was the flag bearer for Ireland at the papal welcome. The K and L group participated in the main events including the vigil and the final Mass celebrated by Pope Francis, which was attended by an estimated 2 million people. Pilgrims attended ceremonies with Pope Francis on four different occasions. Kildare and Leighlin Diocese led evening prayer for all Irish pilgrims. The next world youth day will take place in Panama in 2019.



Harvest Mass: This year's Harvest Mass will be held next weekend the 23rd of October in both Derrinturn and Kilshanroe Churches. At these masses, we give thanks for the abundant harvest of crops and turf in the Parish in 2016. Everyone in the Parish is very welcome to join in thanksgiving.
