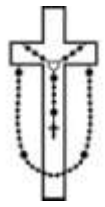

**Our 2016 Annual Novena for departed relatives and friends** will take place in our Parish from Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> of November until Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> of November inclusive. We are unable to take individual mass bookings during this time, but will accommodate mass bookings either side of these dates. On the weekend of the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> of November at the 7.30pm, 8am and 11am Masses in Derrinturn and at the 7.30pm and 11am Masses in Kilshanroe we will light an individual candle for those who have died in the last year. We will also light one large candle for all the dead over the years. May they all rest in peace.

**Mission Month of October:** Today is Mission Sunday. It is the one day when we are specifically asked to dig into our hearts and minds and assist our Church's universal mission. Our theme for this year's Mission Sunday is 'Every Christian is a Missionary'. We all have the privilege of sharing God's love and words with those who have not yet heard Him.

Pope Francis is an enthusiastic 'promoter' of this theme and is seeking to lead all of us in a joyful expression of our individual and unique missionary charism. In his message for Mission Sunday the Pope says "As they travel through the streets of the world, the disciples of Jesus need to have a love without limits, the same measure of love that our Lord has for all people. **‘Marbhna – A Requiem Mass’** composed by Odhran O’Casaide at Knock Basilica 12 noon Sunday November 6<sup>th</sup>, commemorating all those who died in 1916. Requiem 1916 Marbhna, in Irish, featuring the voice of Sibéal Ní Casaide, is a solemn expression of commemoration. It sets out to explore the beauty of sean nós voice, together with chamber choir and orchestra, classical solo voices, traditional and early music instruments. The blend of Irish and classical music reflects two great musical traditions in Ireland at the time of the Rising. The musical motifs are carried seamlessly from genre to genre. It is the first orchestral setting of a Dies Ires in the Irish language.
