The 9th World Meeting of Families will take place in Ireland. Pope Francis has asked for the 2018 World Meeting of Families to take place in Dublin with the theme "The Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World". It is an international pastoral event and will take place from 22nd to 26th of August 2018. The first World Meeting of Families took place in Rome in 1994, the International Year of the Family. Every three years since 1994, families from all over the world are invited by the Holy Father to attend this global gathering. During a World Meeting, families come together to share experiences, to dialogue, to pray and work together to grow as individuals and as family units. Delegates participate in discussion groups on the role of the Christian family in the Church and society, and are addressed by distinguished speakers. The eighth and most recent World Meeting took place in Philadelphia in September 2015.
