### *Next Week's Gospel Mt 10 26-33*



Today is the 11<sup>th</sup> of June, we celebrate **Trinity Sunday**: Masses for the day are 8am Derrinturn Church. At 11am, Mass will take place as usual at Trinity Well and 11am Mass in Kilshanroe. Trinity Sunday, officially called "*The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity*," is one of the few celebrations of the Christian Year that commemorates a reality and doctrine rather than a person or event. On

Trinity Sunday, Christians remember and honour the eternal God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Trinity Sunday is celebrated the Sunday after Pentecost, and it lasts only one day, which is symbolic of the unity of the Trinity.

**Second Apparition anniversary 1917-2017:** Our lady of Fatima Rosary will be held in both Derrinturn & Kilshanroe Churches on Tuesday the 13<sup>th</sup> of June at 7pm to mark the 100 year anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima. Our Lady appeared to three little children from May to October, 1917 and one of her requests was for the faithful to pray the Rosary each day. So why not join us on the 13th as we honour Our Lady of Fatima.



**Cemetery Sunday** takes place this year in Carbury Parish on Sunday July the 2<sup>nd</sup> in Derrinturn Cemetery at 3pm and the following Sunday, July the 9<sup>th</sup> at 3pm in our cemetery in Kilshanroe.
