

Pentecost Sunday

Today, Sunday the 4th of June, is *Pentecost* Sunday, when the Church celebrates the *descent of the Holy Spirit* on the Apostles (Acts 2:1-41). Pentecost is often regarded as the Church's birthday because from that point on the apostles carried the message of Christ.

The 7 gifts of the Holy spirit are: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety and Fear of the Lord. Pick one and ask God for it.

The 12 Fruits of the Holy Spirit are: Charity, Joy, Peace, Patience, Benignity, Goodness. Longanimity, Mildness, Faith, Modesty, Continency and Chastity.
