## **Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary – Tuesday August 15<sup>th</sup>.**

All the feast days of Our Lady mark the great mysteries of her life and her part in the work of redemption. The central mystery of her life and person is her divine motherhood, celebrated both at Christmas and a week later on January 1<sup>st</sup> on the feast of the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God.

The Immaculate Conception on December the 8<sup>th</sup> marks the preparation for that motherhood, so that she had the fullness of grace from the first moment of her existence, completely untouched by sin.

The Assumption completes God's work, since it was not fitting that the flesh that had given life to God himself should ever undergo corruption. The Assumption is God's crowning of His work as Mary ends her earthly life and enters eternity. The feast turns our eyes in that direction, where we will follow when our earthly life is over. The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they do not look only to the past. They look to the present and to the future and give us an insight into our own relationship with God. The Assumption looks to eternity and gives us hope that we, too, will follow Our Lady when our life is ended. The prayer for the feast reads: "All-powerful and ever-living God: You raised the sinless Virgin Mary, mother of your Son, body and soul, to the glory of heaven. May we see heaven as our final goal and come to share her glory."

**Vigil Mass for the feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary takes place in Kilshanroe Church at 7.30pm on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> August and on Tuesday the 15<sup>th</sup> of August in Derrinturn Church at 9.30am and 7.30pm.**
