Fun, friendship and faith on the menu for Kildare and Leighlin Diocesan family picnic in Punchestown Sunday 27th August from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m

Bishop Denis Nulty, is inviting families across the 56 parishes of the diocese of Kildare and Leighlin to a 'Picnic in Punchestown' on the last Sunday of August. The picnic is part of diocesan preparations for next year's World Meeting of Families and is also an opportunity to reach out to all families of the diocese and to gather them together for an event filled with fun, friendship and faith! Families have been asked to bring along their own picnic with a bit of extra food for a sharing table for those who maybe don't have enough to eat. A special invitation has been issued to the families living in the two direct provision centres in the diocese, in Newbridge and Portlaoise, and also the refugee centre in Monasterevin. Bishop Nulty said that the diocese will be putting together special baskets for these families.

The family picnic will take place at Punchestown Racecourse on Sunday 27th August from 1.p.m until 6.p.m, with an official opening liturgy at 3.p.m. Bishop Denis will lead a 4km fun walk around the race track and there will be face-painting, pet corner, stilt walkers, and lots of children's activities and games.

Speaking ahead of the event Bishop Nulty said, *"We all liked going on a family picnic years ago and I think we don't do it enough of it now, because we spend more time on phones and on the internet and spend less quality time with one another"* *"With this family picnic we want a sense of bringing together of families and a sense that we are a Church out in the field. It's a bringing together of people."*

Launch of the World Meeting of Families 2018 programme 'Amoris: Let's talk Family, Let's be Family!'. One of the main highlights of the 2017 Knock Novena will take place on Monday 21st of August with the launch of the World Meeting of Families 2018 programme 'Amoris: Let's talk Family, Let's be Family!'. Families representing each diocese will travel to Knock for this special day.

A newly commissioned Icon of the Holy Family will be unveiled and anointed in the Basilica following which, the Icon will travel to each diocese around the country as part of the WMOF2018 celebrations. It is also hoped to have a special 'Witness Walk' at 7pm, prior to the Novena evening Mass. This is to remember the witnesses and follows a route around the village and Shrine grounds followed by a special blessing in the Apparition Chapel. Very Rev Diarmuid Martin, Archbishop of Dublin will highlight family life with '*When Plates Fly! Pope Francis on the joys and challenges of family life*' and workshops will be facilitated by Fr Timothy Bartlett on how to make technology more family friendly.

The Novena will come to a close on Tuesday 22nd August with Maria Steen, spokesperson for the Iona Institute at the ceremonies and workshops with Cora Sherlock, Deputy Chairperson of the Pro Life Campaign.

Heritage Week in County Kildare Saturday 19th to Sunday 27th August 2017

Tower of Allen on the Hill of Allen will be open as follows: Saturday 19th to Sunday 27th August (inclusive) from 10am to 6pm. Just 10km from Newbridge and Kildare and 18km from Carbury

this magnificent tower was built in 1859 by Sir Gerald George Aylmer. The tower commands extensive views of the surrounding countryside. On each step of the tower is inscribed the names of the men and women who built it. Go and visit this great piece of our local history.

Community Food and Farming: Food brings people together. We experience nature and the seasons in the vegetables we grow and eat. The global movement of Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a model for doing just that. A demonstration of this takes place 19th August from 11am to 12pm in Derrybeg Organic Farm. Derrybeg Farm is located on the Maynooth Road, Celbridge between the Base entertainment centre and the new Celbridge Community School; opposite Salesians College. There is parking along the road and the 67 bus stops outside. The terrain is rough and therefore not easily accessible for wheelchairs or buggies. We recommend bringing wellingtons in case the weather makes the ground wet. Admission is free.

National Science Museum NUI Maynooth Co. Kildare: Come and view the largest display of scientific instruments on public display in Ireland. Most of which were manufactured in the Dublin area between 1880 and 1920. Dates for this event are 20th August, 2pm - 6pm 23rd August, 2pm - 4pm and the 24th of August, 2pm - 6pm. Admission is free.
