**Fun, friendship and faith on the menu for Kildare and Leighlin Diocesan family picnic in Punchestown, today Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> August from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m**

Bishop Denis Nulty, is inviting families across the 56 parishes of the diocese of Kildare and Leighlin to a 'Picnic in Punchestown' on the last Sunday of August. The picnic is part of diocesan preparations for next year's World Meeting of Families and is also an opportunity to reach out to all families of the diocese and to gather them together for an event filled with fun, friendship and faith! Families have been asked to bring along their own picnic with a bit of extra food for a sharing table for those who maybe don't have enough to eat. A special invitation has been issued to the families living in the two direct provision centres in the diocese, in Newbridge and Portlaoise, and also the refugee centre in Monasterevin. Bishop Nulty said that the diocese will be putting together special baskets for these families.

The family picnic will take place at Punchestown Racecourse on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> August from 1.p.m until 6.p.m, with an official opening liturgy at 3.p.m. Bishop Denis will lead a 4km fun walk around the race track and there will be face-painting, pet corner, stilt walkers, and lots of children's activities and games.

Speaking ahead of the event Bishop Nulty said, *"We all liked going on a family picnic years ago and I think we don't do it enough of it now, because we spend more time on phones and on the internet and spend less quality time with one another"* *"With this family picnic we want a sense of bringing together of families and a sense that we are a Church out in the field. It's a bringing together of people."*

## Carbury Parish Trip to Knock 2017



61 people travelled to Knock on the Feast Day of Our Lady of Knock. We were blessed with some lovely fine weather and heavy showers of rain. We had our own Mass in the chapel at the back of the church where our lady appeared to 19 local people back in 1879. That apparition lasted for 2 hours in the pouring rain.

At 3 o'clock we had Mass in the Basilica. It was packed to the rafters and there was anointing of the sick. At the Mass Bernadette McNeive spoke of the importance of organ donation and her own personal experience of her son receiving a kidney at 11 years old. He now competes for Ireland and has won medals at the transplant games internationally. He also did his leaving certificate this year.

After Mass at 5pm we headed for home and stopped at Moate for a meal. Then we were entertained by singers young and old on the journey home. We discovered plenty of talent in Carbury! We should mention that going to Knock we had a 15 minute break in Athlone. It will be a feature of next year's journey please God.
