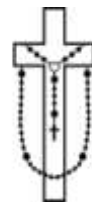

Society of Missionary Children's "Family Album" and the World Meeting of Families!



Next August the World Meeting of Families takes place in Dublin. With this in mind, the Society of Missionary Children (the Pope's official children's charity for overseas mission) with the support of the World Meeting of Families is creating a "Family Album" to bring to the World Meeting of Families! This will be a digital

collection of drawings, or other artwork from children, adolescents, and their families, providing everyone with the opportunity to illustrate what family means to them. We would invite you to participate as creatively as possible in the Society's "Family Album." Pope Francis says that through beauty, artists make the world better! He also says that living together is an art, a patient, beautiful, fascinating journey so, what better way for families to express the art of living together as family than through art. Artists can use any type of paper, white, coloured, rough or smooth. Their work may be drawn or painted, in pencil, charcoal, pen and ink, crayon, pastel, watercolour etc.. However, the size of artwork should not be smaller than A4 or larger than A2. It is best that all pieces are submitted not rolled, folded or framed and that the artist puts their name and age on the reverse side of their work. Mission Month of October: World Mission Sunday is next week! Please remember that the Holy Father invites all Catholics to contribute to a special collection, the Mission Sunday collection. World Missions Ireland is the Holy Father's official charity for overseas mission and is responsible for coordinating Mission Sunday in

Ireland. The World Mission collection envelope in the Parish Development envelope box. Mission Month gives us all the opportunity to reflect on our baptismal call to bring Christ to others, which is a privilege in itself. The gift we have been given, we are asked to give. Our gift to the world is the joy of the Gospel and our Irish missionaries continue to bring the Good News to people throughout the world. World Missions Ireland, the working title of the four Pontifical mission societies, organises the Mission Sunday collection in all Churches nationwide. Mission Sunday falls on the 22nd October this year. The theme is **'Reach out and spread the joy'**. We can all do our part in an open, joyful and generous way.

Mission Sunday is a Papal collection taken at Mass on the second last Sunday in October. It supports 1,069 dioceses in 157 countries around the world where the Universal Church is too new, young or poor to survive without our help. All parishes throughout the world celebrate Mission Sunday because it is vital to the growth of the Church in predominantly impoverished and remote areas overseas. The funds raised build much-needed infrastructure, from chapels and schools, to orphanages, clinics and dispensaries. The support from World Missions Ireland transforms lives and creates a hub from which the young Church can flourish and grow: spreading the Good News of the Gospel, ministering to the faithful and delivering essential services in health and education. Mission Sunday is one of only three Papal collections and has been especially chosen by the Holy Father as the means by which we share what we have with our brothers and sisters in need.
