

This gives you the option of selecting a ticket for the Festival of Families and /or the Closing Mass for no additional cost. An adult ticket for a day at the congress costs  $\in$ 38 (concessions  $\in$ 33). All U18's are free but must be registered with an adult. There will be exciting and full children and youth programmes running alongside the adult programme, and remember, the Kildare and Leighlin diocesan day at the Congress is Wednesday, the  $22^{nd}$  of August.
