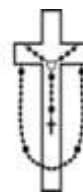

***Canonisation of Blessed Oscar Romero***, Pope Francis officially recognised the sainthood of Oscar Romero, Archbishop of San Salvo on Sunday at a ceremony in Rome. It is a fitting tribute to an extraordinary man, whose life still influences the work of Trócaire and similar organisations working for human rights around the world. *“It is not God’s will for some to have everything and others to have nothing”*. *Blessed Oscar Romero*. Archbishop Romero was a great friend of Trócaire. His leadership, conviction and compassion still guide Trócaire’s values of solidarity, participation, perseverance and courage in our work today. In 1979, we began funding the El Salvador Human Rights Commission, which was set up by the Archbishop, in response to the unlawful killing of 8,000 people. Trócaire received a letter from Monsignor Romero dated 1 March 1980 asking for funding to restore the broadcasting unit. He wrote *“Not having the radio deprives us of a means so important here”*. He also wrote in the same letter *“I would like to thank your kindness and preoccupation for our country and our Church and the kindness of the Irish Bishop’s Conference and Trócaire’s”*. Two weeks after writing this letter, Archbishop Romero was brutally murdered. Archbishop Romero’s death was not in vain. Today his legacy continues to be deeply embedded in the work of Trócaire.

### **Knock Shrine Annual All-Night Vigil of Atonement & Reparation** December 7<sup>th</sup>.

The Vigil is now in its 46th year it celebrates and honours the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Organised by the director of the Eucharistic Apostolate of Atonement for Mercy, the Vigil is inspired by the spirituality of the Venerable Archbishop Fulton J Sheen. Traditionally, upwards of 5,000 pilgrims have attended the All Night Vigil of Atonement at Knock Shrine. The programme for the night begins on December 7th at 10pm with confessions until 12 midnight in the

Reconciliation Chapel at Knock. The vigil commences at 12 midnight in the Basilica with Rosary, Stations of the Cross and Holy Hour. Concelebrated Mass at 4am on December 8th with main celebrant His Excellency Archbishop Okolo, Papal Nuncio with concelebrants Fr Brendan Walsh and Fr Lawrence CFR. Music will be provided by Knock Shrine's music director, Una Nolan, and soloists James Kilbane and Deirdre Parle.
