A Date for Your Diary: Chrism Mass 2019

Monday, April 15, 7:30 p.m. in the Cathedral of the Assumption, Carlow. Once more parishes are invited to have their parish banner included in the opening procession.

Bishop Denis warmly invites parishioners from across the diocese to join him for this Mass during which the priests of the diocese will renew their priestly promises and the Oil of Catechumens, Oil of the Sick and Chrism will be blessed and consecrated for use in parishes in the coming year. *Our Diocese – a family of parishes*

Chrism Mass: Once more parishes are invited to have their parish banner included in the opening procession. There is quite a number of banners in FDS office so if you can't locate yours you might check in with Christine!! Practical details will follow as regards arrival time etc but for now parishes are asked to nominate a parishioner to carry it – bearing in mind the weight of the banner and standing time for the individual. Parishes are also asked to ENSURE THAT THERE IS AN EYELET AT EACH END OF THE BANNER that will be used to attach the banner to eyehooks on the banner pole.
