### **Kilshanroe Old School Restoration Project:**

The earliest records of a school in Kilshanroe date back to pre-famine times when a small mud and thatch schoolhouse was opened in 1817. This was one of the very first schools in our local area and was upgraded in 1852 with a stone building, the remains of which can still be seen today. The old school was a one-room building with an open fire and was used right through until the 1960's when the new primary school was opened.

With the passage of time, the old structure fell into disrepair and some initial restoration works commenced last autumn with volunteers cleaning up the site and removing ivy and briars in an attempt to halt its decline. Since then we have erected a new fence, pruned the large horse chestnut tree, reinstalled window heads and door head and restored much of the fallen & damaged stonework. Much remains to be done and further works will recommence as the weather improves.

Many thanks to everybody from the local community who helped in getting us to this stage. New volunteers are always welcome and any contributions to the ongoing restoration work or offers of labour or materials are much appreciated.
