Baptisms: To book a Baptism please contact the Parish Office during office hours. Please note that the Diocesan guidelines for Godparents are that they must be baptised and confirmed Catholics who are committed to sharing their faith with their Godchild. They must be 16 years old or more, one male and one female. It is permitted for a baptised non-Catholic to act as a “witness” (instead of one Godparent).
