COVID-19 Diocesan Update from Bishop Denis:

The announcement that the entire country is moving to Level 3 of the '*National Framework for living with COVID-19*' has huge repercussions for our diocese. Briefly I just want to remind you of the following points:

- **Masses:** No public Masses are allowed in Level 3, all Masses to go online as from midnight tonight. All churches are to remain open for private prayer.
- **First Communions / Confirmations:** I am aware many ceremonies are scheduled for the coming weekends, sadly all ceremonies are to be postponed until a later date.
- **Baptisms:** Planned baptisms for the coming days or weeks are unfortunately to be deferred until a suitable date can be arranged later.
- **Funerals:** The maximum that can attend a funeral in Level 3 is 25.
- **Marriages:** The maximum that can attend a wedding in Level 3 is 25.

I realise this is very hard on all of you, I also think of the children and couples waiting to celebrate huge moments in their lives. I ask you to remember each other in prayer at this time.

- At Holy Communion time, make an Act of Spiritual Communion.
- And finally, go in peace – to live what you have prayed.
- Don't forget to donate on line or by other means to your Parish if you can.
