## **Taking steps to care for our common Home**

**Plastic:** Minimise the use of products that are made from or packaged with plastic. *Plastic is unfriendly to the environment. It is produced from our limited non-renewable oil reserves and it does not bio-degrade. It is estimated that it takes up to 500 years for plastic to break down in a landfill.* Dispose of plastic with a reputable waste management provider. *Carelessly and illegally dumped plastic finding its way into the world's seas has become a major global environmental problem, causing the death of countless marine creatures.* Many cosmetic products – soaps, shower gels, facial scrubs – contain microbeads (tiny plastic balls). *Microbeads have the potential to get into the waterways and be eaten by fish, thus getting into the food chain and eventually into products eaten by humans.* Be sparing in using cling film. *Considering the raw materials and energy needed for the manufacture of cling film, along with the fact that it cannot be recycled and is rarely reused, cling film is definitely not environmentally friendly.* Avoid buying Styrofoam cups and containers. *Styrofoam does not biodegrade and can leak toxins into the groundwater under landfills. It has the same effect as plastic when it breaks down in the ocean.* Treating yourself to an ice cream? *Buy a cone instead of a tub. This will ensure that you do not add an empty tub and a plastic spoon to the waste mountain.* Do not organise or take part in balloon releases. *Release balloons can become a menace to wildlife.*

### **Second Round of the COVID-19 Emergency Fund:**

The Department of Rural and Community Development and Carlow Local Community Development Committee (Carlow LCDC) invites applications for grant funding under the second Round of the COVID-19 Emergency Fund.


The COVID-19 Emergency Fund is designed to assist community-based organisations that are facing increased demands or additional costs due to the pandemic. Funding will be considered for groups to: -

- assist in Community support as part of the Community Call effort e.g. meals on wheels; deliveries; phone calls etc.
- adapt their services and operations to fit the new COVID-19 reality. e.g. adapting premises; offering on-line activities; providing social supports and friendly calls by phone etc.
- become more involved in the Government's 'Keep Well' campaign, in particular, with the three themes: staying connected, switching off and being creative, and minding your mood.

Applications should be typically for €1,000 or less but amounts greater will be considered if the community need is demonstrated.
