Opportunity to Take Stock & Reflect Pope St John Paul II so deeply expressed in his Encyclical Letter on the Eucharist: ‘The Church draws her life from the Eucharist. This truth does not simply express a daily experience of faith, but recapitulates *the heart of the mystery of the Church*. In a variety of ways she joyfully experiences the constant fulfilment of the promise: “Lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age” (Mt 28:20), but in the Holy Eucharist, through the changing of bread and wine into the body and blood of the Lord, she rejoices in this presence with unique intensity. Ever since Pentecost, when the Church, the People of the New Covenant, began her pilgrim journey towards her heavenly homeland, the Divine Sacrament has continued to mark the passing of her days, filling them with confident hope.’ (*Ecclesia de Eucharistia* 1). As we return or prepare to return to the Celebration of Mass still in the Joy of Eastertide, we could consider the following: **(1)** Bringing with us all the difficulties and challenges that this pandemic has brought with it and perhaps some positive aspects too and leaving them at the Lord’s feet. **(2)** Remembering that we are part of a Faith Community and connecting/reconnecting with it in some way. Reader’s/Eucharistic Ministers returning. Helping to sanitize the Church. **(3)** We could consider receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation/Confession. **(4)** Maybe read Pope St John Paul II’s writings on the Eucharist ‘*Ecclesia de Eucharistia*’ (which is available online for free) or other Spiritual books or the Daily Mass readings.

Pentecost Sunday: Today, Sunday the 23rd of May, is *Pentecost* Sunday, when the Church celebrates the *descent of the Holy Spirit* on the Apostles (Acts 2:1-41). Pentecost is often regarded as the Church’s birthday because from that point on the apostles carried the message of Christ. The symbols of Pentecost are the flame, wind, and the dove, which represents the Holy Spirit. The colour of Pentecost is red and the priest wears red vestments on this day.

The 7 gifts of the Holy spirit are: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety and Fear of the Lord.

Pick one and ask God for it.

The 12 Fruits of the Holy Spirit are: Charity, Joy, Peace, Patience, Benignity, Goodness, Longanimity, Mildness, Faith, Modesty, Continency and Chastity.

Mass for Trinity Sunday: Due to the ongoing restrictions of the numbers allowed to meet outdoors due to the Covid 19, the Mass due to take place for Trinity Sunday at the the well on the 30th May will not be taking place this year.
