Living 'Laudato Sí': This week be aware of and try to minimise the use of products that are made from or packaged with plastic. Plastic is unfriendly to the environment. It is produced from limited non-renewable oil reserves and it does not biodegrade. It is estimated that it takes 500 years for plastic to break down in a landfill. *'Account must also be taken of the pollution produced by residue, including dangerous waste present in different areas. Each year hundreds of millions of tons of waste are generated, much of it non-biodegradable, highly toxic and radioactive, from homes and businesses, from construction and demolition sites, from clinical, electronic and industrial sources. The earth, our home, is beginning to look more and more like an immense pile of filth.'* (Laudato Sí 21)
