The first ever house was founded by an Italian nun, Mother Elvira, in 1983 in Saluzzo, northern Italy, in an effort to help people through drug abuse and addiction. Today, there are now over 70 Cenacolo houses worldwide and they all rely totally on voluntary contributions and donations.
