County Kildare calls for a pause for peace on St Brigid's Day: Into Kildare, the Tourism Board for County Kildare and Solas Bhríde Spirituality Centre & Hermitages have jointly launched a global 'Pause for Peace' movement. Pause for Peace will see the residents of County Kildare calling on people all around the world to stop for a minute's silence at 12.00 noon on St Brigid's day, the 1st of February 2023. Next year, 2024, marks the 1500th anniversary of the death of St. Brigid. In preparation, various activities and movements will take place in 2023. The Pause for Peace movement is one of those special events, which give recognition to the importance of St. Brigid from a cultural, religious, spiritual and historical point of view.

St. Brigid's Day Crosses made by the children of St Brigid's National School, Ticknevin, will be available for sale at masses on Saturday 28th at 7.30pm at Kilshanroe Church and Sunday 29th of January at 11am at Derrinturn Church. All monies raised will go towards school funds. The St. Brigid's Cross was traditionally believed to protect the house from fire and disease. As people hung up the cross, they said this prayer: *"May the blessing of God and the Trinity be on this cross, and on the home where it hangs and on everyone who looks at it."*
