Knock Shrine – The Knock Youth Leadership Programme: This programme aims to train leaders to volunteer within their parish to journey with children and young people as they explore and deepen their faith. On completion of the programme (2 weekends and 11 Saturdays over an 18-month period) participants will receive two certificates: A certificate in Youth Ministries (accredited by Queens University Belfast).
