All-Ireland Pollinator Plan: The All-Ireland Pollinator Plan is an island-wide attempt to reverse declines in pollinating insects. One third of our bee species are threatened with extinction in Ireland. The good news is that you can help by making your garden pollinator friendly. Ministry of Lay Pastoral Worker: We are inviting Lay people to formally train in the role of Pastoral Worker. These roles will support parishes and pastoral areas in a range of ministries including catechesis (sacramental preparation, adult faith formation etc.), care support (to work with the sick, housebound and families who are bereaved), leaders in prayer and liturgies and administration (especially in parishes without a resident ordained priest). Applications will be invited in November/December 2024 with selection commencing early January 2025. Those selected will enter a period of discernment from February to June 2025. The course is a two-year diploma in Pastoral Ministry commencing in September 2025. It is delivered by Mount St Anne’s and accredited by St Patricks Pontifical University, Maynooth. Participants will attend lectures over six residential weekends each year along with 80 hours pastoral placement. Pastoral Placement includes group and individual pastoral reflection. On successful completion of the course the participants will be awarded a Level 7 Diploma in Pastoral Ministry.
